Among the things we recently shipped we sent over 500 hard copies of the first 3 sets of our BCC lessons. These will be used in Africa and graded there as well so there will be no postage in sending them back to the USA for grading. We have done just about all we can do before our trip begins. We plan to teach 6 hours each day at Zambia School of Biblical Studies in Livingstone, Zambia. We will be going to the bush 2 or 3 times to conduct Gospel Meetings. Joining Carolyn and me this year will be Rusty & Laura Stark and Barry Gilreath, Jr. We are looking forward to working with these fine folks and to the work there in Zambia. We plan to purchase several bikes for preachers while we are there and as many Bibles in different languages as we have funds to purchase. We are taking several suits, ties, shirts and shoes for the preachers. We are also taking 3 or 4 laptop computers to give to the preacher schools and a printer. We will give a full report concerning this trip when we return and a financial report to those who helped with this trip.

Our distance learning students are excited about the new books we have posted on our web page at <u>www.icotb.org</u> under the tab "Gospel Books". There are around 75 books posted and we plan to put several more there as we can each month. These books are not just for our students. They are for anyone who wants to study and learn more of God's Word. I encourage you to visit this web page and look over these good books. I want to personally thank Linda for all the work she does in keeping our BCC program running smoothly. There is much she does in assigning the new students to teachers and keeping in touch with our over 100 volunteer teachers and all the posting on our web pages. We appreciate her diligent work.
